TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility requirement - an individual is a person in a community with limited access to technology and with a disability, or an individual is a person in a community with limited access to technology and a member of a low-income family per definition below:
 - Limited access to technology
 - Disability means a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more of the major life activities of such individual; a record of such impairment; or being regarded as having such an impairment.
 - Low-income - up to 280% of Federal poverty level. For 2016 these thresholds are as follows:

2. **Complete the Individual Application Form on the reverse in its entirety and return with all relevant supporting documentation to Ability Built Computers for review.** Incomplete or illegible applications will not be processed.
3. There is a maximum of two computers per application per year. Applications are valid for two years.
4. Once applications are reviewed, applicants are notified of application status and, if approved, a time is scheduled for pickup of computer system at a distribution event or from our warehouse.
5. Computers are available on a first-come, first-served basis — availability of a computer system is not guaranteed.
6. Desktop computer systems include the computer base unit, monitor, keyboard, mouse and cables. Desktop systems generally do not have built-in speakers or wireless capability. Laptops include the computer and charger.
7. A fee will be paid to Ability Built Computers at the time of pick up. Cash or a valid credit/debit card (Mastercard or Visa only) are accepted forms of payment. Personal checks are NOT accepted.
8. A “no show” for your scheduled pickup appointment will result in the need to reapply and/or the loss of any event discounts.
